FREE FROM ALIVE INSECTS AND ALIVE ARACHNIDS

Broken and foreign matter. Broken wheat is those grains or pieces of grains (not damaged) of wheat bread that pass by a sieve of 4/64-inch (1.60 mm) x 2/64-inch (9.5 mm).

Foreign matters are those grains or pieces of grains which are not of wheat bread and all other matter inert

Damaged kernels include grains or pieces of grains that have a substantial alteration in their constitution. Is considered as such to them burning or damaged by heat, grains green, frozen, sprouted, gnawed by insects and gnawed on their germ-

Burned Grains and Heat Damaged are those grains or pieces of grains that have a darkening in its tonality natural, due to process fermentation or to the action of high temperatures.

White belly grains: are those that are characterized by its texture similar to the starch in a half or more than the grain, which is appreciated by a coloration external yellowish defined.

Chopped beans: they are those who have perforations caused by the attack of insects.
